Use the sheet provided to:-

Level 1: Practise and know your 2x, 5x and 10x tables by heart.

Level 2: Practise and know your 2x, 5x, 10x, 3x and 4x tables by heart.

Level 3: Practise and know all your times tables facts.

P.S. – Champion mathematicians will keep practising these all the time – just once won't be enough! See how quick you can get at recalling the facts out of order!

Literacy: L.O: *To create your own monster.*

At school we have been looking at the myths and legends of Ancient Greece which were dominated by tales of heroes, gods and monsters. After half term our work is going to be centred around monsters generally. The task over the autumn half term holiday is to create your own monster.

All levels

- Draw a picture of your monster and label the different parts that your monster's body would have. E.g. head, eyes, nose, mouth, ears and legs.
- Write a word to describe what its head is like, e.g. gigantic head, and write a describing word to go with each part of your monster. (Try not to use the same describing word twice.)
- Can you write a list of other describing words for your monster?

Level 2 & 3

- Write a couple of paragraphs about your monster. Things to include:-
 - Where it lives
 - How it behaves
 - What it does to the heroes that come across it
