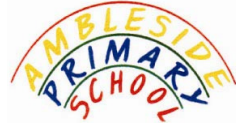


Level 2 Homework – 22.01.10

2. One afternoon 145 people watch a film. In the evening 138 people saw the same film. Altogether, how many people watched the film?
3. In Year 4 there are 75 children. Of these, 49 bring a packed lunch. How many children do not have a packed lunch?
4. On each bus there are 47 people. How many people will there be on three buses if they were all full?
5. A city has 244 buses. On a Sunday 186 were in use taking people all over the city. How many buses were not in use?
6. A factory is building 53 rally cars. It needs five wheels for each car. Altogether, how many wheels does the factory need?
7. My 4 digits are all different. They are odd and in order, largest first. The sum of my first and last digits is 10. The sum of my middle two digits is also 10. What number am I?
