4. Andrew has 90 stickers in a book. He finds another 20 stickers in a drawer and then buys another 60. How many has he altogether?
5. Vicky plants 67 bulbs. Only 53 of them flower. How many bulbs do not flower?
6. At a school there are 175 children in the infants and 252 in the juniors. Due to illness 66 children do not come to school. How many children are in school?
7. I am more than 20. I am the sum of three different odd single-digit numbers. What am I?
