Maths / L.O: Be able to solve maths word problems.

1. I pay £3.60 (three pounds sixty pence) for a rail ticket. How much change should I get from a £5 (five pound) note?
2. One length of the swimming pool is 25m (metres). Jane swims 5 lengths of the pool. How far does Jane swim altogether?
3. Kiz swims 225m (metres) in the pool. How many lengths does he swim?
4. The temperature in York is 4°C. Rome is 7 degrees colder than York. What is the temperature in Rome?
5. Jenny can walk 103m (metres) in 1 minute. How far can she walk in 2 minutes?
6. There are 56 red and blue balls in a bag. 37 of the balls are red. How many are blue?
7. What is the perimeter of a 7cm by 10cm rectangle? (perimeter = distance around the edge of a shape)
8. It takes Ted 3 hours and 37 minutes to clean his house from top to bottom. If he starts cleaning at 12:19 what time will he be finished?

Literacy / L.O: To be able to identify adverbs in sentences.
