L.O: Be able to solve maths word problems.

1. I have 50% of £36. How much money do I have?
2. Greg lifts 30kg. How many grams does he lift?
3. T-shirts cost £5.99. How much would I have to spend to buy three T-shirts?
4. What is the *product* of 8 and 8? (N.B: The answer is not 16)
5. Subtract 1.9 from 2.7. (*Remember Mr Ring's super-duper tip: make sure all the decimal points line up!*)
6. How many quarters are there in $7\frac{1}{4}$?
7. Calculate the perimeter of a rectangle which is 4m (metres) wide and 7m (metres) long.
8. How many degrees are there in a right angle?
9. Beryl collects milk bottle tops. She has been collecting them at a rate of 480 per year for the last 20 years. How many milk bottle tops does she have in her collection?
10. Susie counts tyres in the car park. There are 54 tyres altogether. There are 3 bikes in the car park. How many cars are there?
