Numeracy:

Be a **Kitchen Raider!**

Check your kitchen cupboards or fridge for measurements! Write down as many weights or volumes that you can find and convert them into points.

Example:



A tin of beans weighs 385g so you earn 385 points.



A pint of milk has a volume of 568ml so you earn 568 points.

Total up your points.

Will you be the champion **Kitchen Raider!** in your class?
