

Literacy/Topic:

Next week we will be looking at the Winter Scene painting and doing some descriptive writing and poetry.

Talk Time: talk with someone at home about what winter means to you.

WOW word collection: To get a head start, create a list of WOW adjectives that you could use in your writing about winter based on your 5 senses.

Set it out like this:

see	hear	feel	smell	taste

**Numeracy:**

Use our standard written method to answer these **subtraction** questions.

e.g.

1. $65 - 43 =$
2. $78 - 48 =$
3. $94 - 76 =$
4. $87 - 59 =$
5. $143 - 78 =$
6. $176 - 77 =$

Can you make up some questions of your own?

Can you create a word problem involving subtraction?

Other Activities:

It has been noticed within numeracy sessions that children are still reciting times tables in order to reach an answer.

Practise your times tables and get someone at home to test you but in a random order.

Try this for starters (time yourself!)

$3 \times 4 =$ $5 \times 4 =$ $9 \times 4 =$ $1 \times 4 =$ $11 \times 4 =$ $6 \times 4 =$ $8 \times 4 =$ $2 \times 4 =$ $7 \times 4 =$ $12 \times 4 =$ $0 \times 4 =$
