Can you find out:

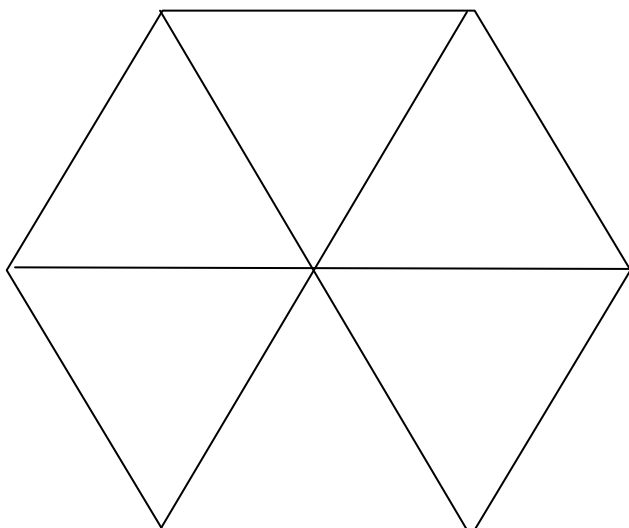
Where the Aztecs were from?
