<p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>Make sure you read something every day. This can be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A newspaper report,<ul style="list-style-type: none">- A poem- A story book- A library book- A letter- A notice board in the supermarket <p>Ask your parent or carer to make a note in your <u>reading diary</u>, so your teachers know you've read!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spelling</p> <p>Practise the words on your own spelling list (animal) regularly.</p> <p>You can do this by:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Looking at the word2. Saying the word out loud3. Cover the word up4. Write the word5. Check the word <p>Most importantly: Practise writing the word in a sentence, or in a story.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <p>No written maths homework this week!</p> <p>You should be practising your times tables and number facts (such as number bonds to <u>every number</u> below 50 eg $3 + 4 = 7$) regularly. Recalling this information quickly is very important in Y5.</p> <p>You could go on Mathletics to practise your maths skills.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Topic</p> <p>Make sure your DARE book is signed.</p> <p>Think of a list of compliments you could give to members of your family. Ask them to think of 3 of 4 compliments for you.</p> <p>Make sure your DARE book is up to date.</p>
