

Issues raised at class and phase councils Autumn 08

Many children felt that they were not getting enough immediate rewards in the classrooms, such as stickers. **Action: Georgia and Kaylem have ordered new stickers for each class. These have been distributed fairly to each class. Phase 4 received pencils, erasers and pencil sharpeners as they felt stickers were a bit 'babyish' for them.**
