Ideas for new academies: Cooking, sport, science, mask making, reading, team games, designing clothes, rugby, advertising, ICT, hairdressing, film making, film watching, drama, Spanish, singing, dance, jewellery making, athletics.</li> <li>3. <u>Issue: Making friends, playing at lunchtime and playtime.</u> Nikita suggest a friendship bench where children can sit if they don't have anybody to play with. When there are two children, they can play together. Or other children can look out for children who sit on the bench and play with them. Nikita feels that the friendship stop doesn't work, because it is too small and children don't notice it and therefore don't stop.</li> </ol> <p><u>Issue: Wet playtimes.</u> Melissa said that she (and other children) would like to be able to visit their friends in other classes when it is wet playtime.</p> <p>Issue: State of the Library Miss Nusselder said that 6 Y5 children have been appointed as librarians and will regularly tidy up. Mrs Hilliard will also be there 3 days a week.</p> <p><u>Issue: food on the hall floor when children go in for assembly, wet floor</u></p> <p><u>Issue: we need more equipment on the playground to use at playtime and dinner time.</u></p> <p><u>Issue: toilets; locks don't work, children don't flush, no soap</u> Miss Nusselder will finish the podcast about toilets, so that each class can watch it and be aware of the problems.</p> <p><u>Issue: football at dinner time; at the moment the boys can play football on 3 days, and the girls can have 2 days.</u> Suggestion: Monday – boys, Tuesday – girls, Wednesday – boys, Thursday – girls, Friday week A – boys, Friday Week B – girls.</p>
