2.	I can join in with rote counting to 10.			
3.	I can reliably count at least 5 objects.			
4.	I can answer the question 'How many?'			
5.	I know words which mean add and what I have to do.			
6.	I know words which mean subtract and what I have to do.			

<u>Pre-level 1 - numbers and calculation - P8</u>		Me	Me	Adult
1.	I can rote count beyond 10.			
2.	I can recognise numbers to 10.			
3.	I can rote count starting at a number other than 1.			
4.	I can find a number 1 more or less than a given number ( numbers 1-5)			
5.	I can use words such as first second and third.			
6.	I know the numbers 1 to 9 and can match them to the correct group of objects.			
7.	I can compare quantities saying which is more or less.			
8.	I can recognise numbers 1-5 and match them to the correct quantity.			
9.	I can compare quantities when the difference is less obvious e.g. more or less biscuits on a plate when 4 and 5.
